

NRMP Match and AOA Match: Policy Comparison

• N	Match Agreement	Applicants agree to adhere to the terms of the Applicant Agreement and Institutions agree to adhere to the Terms of Institution Participation as part of the Match registration process. AOA programs are registered by their institution.	ALL participants (applicants, program staff, institutional officials, and medical school officials) agree to comply with the terms of the applicable <i>Match Participation Agreement</i> as part of the Match registration process.
• N	Match Commitment	A match constitutes a <i>binding obligation</i> between the applicant and matched institution.	A match constitutes a binding commitment to enter training in good faith on the date specified in the appointment contract.
• 0	Contract	Applicants and programs enter into a contract with each other if a match occurs. Institutions must issue a contract within ten (10) days of obtaining Match results. Applicants must sign the contract within thirty (30) days of receipt from matched institution.	Applicants, schools, institutions, and programs enter into a contract with the NRMP when they execute the MPA. Upon matching, programs forward letters of appointment. Applicants are expected to return a signed copy before the deadline stated in letter.
• N	Match Enforcement	The binding obligation can be terminated through written release obtained by mutual consent from matched parties.	The binding commitment can be terminated <u>ONLY</u> by the NRMP through the waiver process. • Applicants and programs <u>CANNOT</u> release each other from a match commitment.
• 0	Coercion	Applicants and programs may express interest in each other, but statements implying a commitment are prohibited. Neither party can request ranking information.	Applicants and programs may express interest in each other, but statements implying a commitment are prohibited. Neither party can request ranking information, and programs cannot ask <u>ANY</u> information about programs to which an applicant has or may apply.
C	Withdrawal for Concurrent Year Positions	Applicants who match through the AOA will be withdrawn automatically from the Main Residency Match (if registered) for a concurrent year appointment. <i>Applicants who obtain positions in</i> <i>the AOA Scramble</i> <u>MUST</u> withdraw themselves from the Main Residency Match prior to the NRMP Rank Order List Deadline.	Applicants who match through the AOA will be withdrawn automatically from the Main Residency Match (if registered) for a concurrent year appointment. <i>Applicants who obtain positions in the</i> <i>AOA Scramble</i> <u>MUST</u> withdraw themselves from the Main Residency Match prior to the NRMP Rank Order List Deadline.
• V	Vaiver	No waiver review process.	If an applicant and program cannot or will not honor the binding commitment, a waiver must be requested from the NRMP.
	Noncompliance: /iolation	Applicants who fail to sign and return their contract within the specified 30 days may be in breach of the Applicant Agreement.	Any participant who violates any term of the applicable Match Participation Agreement may be investigated for a potential breach of NRMP policy and sanctions may be applied.

•	Noncompliance: Sanctions for Applicants and Programs	Applicants who refuse to accept the binding obligation absent release from the matched institution may be precluded from taking a position in any AOA-accredited training program for one year.	 Applicants with a confirmed violation of NRMP policy: may be barred from Match participation and/or identified as a Match violator in the R3 system for one to three years, or permanently. may be barred for one year from any position in any program sponsored by a Match-participating institution.
