Touro University of Nevada is pleased to announce that we have over one hundred (100) scholarships to award for the 2017-18 academic year. Scholarships will range from \$1,000 to \$5,000. Please read the eligibility criteria for each scholarship opportunity and apply for those that you meet the criteria. Each scholarship has a different essay and may require supporting documentation.

All scholarships, unless otherwise stated, require the following criteria:

- Must be currently enrolled in a degree seeking program at Touro University Nevada;
- Students must have an overall 3.0 cumulative GPA in the program;
- Be currently enrolled in at least six credits; and
- Demonstrate financial need. Therefore, you must have a completed <u>2017-18</u> Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file with the U.S. Department of Education (<u>www.fafsa.gov</u>). Your FAFSA/SAR must reflect <u>Touro University – Vallejo, CA, School</u> <u>Code 041426</u>.

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Touro University Nevada Dean or General Scholarship:

At least one (1) applicant from each program will be awarded the TUN Dean Scholarship. The remaining applicants will be considered for the TUN General Scholarship. Scholarship awards will be \$1,250 or \$2,500.

ESSAY: Please attach a written essay of between 300-500 words describing what it means to you to be a TUN student. Include in your essay how being a TUN student is preparing you to assist with meeting the health/educational needs within your respective program of study.

Jaldeep and Neeta Daulat Scholarship:

All Osteopathic Medicine students who meet the eligibility requirements are encouraged to apply. One 1st or 2nd year Osteopathic Medicine student will be awarded a 3 year scholarship, renewable upon eligibility requirements being confirmed each year.

<u>ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA</u>: To be considered for the Jaldeep and Neeta Daulat Scholarship, you must <u>also</u> meet the following criteria:

- Be an admitted 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th year student in the Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine program; and
- Must demonstrate that you are a first-generation college student as evidenced by the completion of the portion of the *FAFSA* which pertains to parents' education;

ESSAY: Please attach a written essay of between 300-500 words about what it means to you to be a first-generation college student in the TUN Osteopathic Medicine program. Include in your essay the impact this has had on you and/or others.

Clark County Medical Society Scholarship:

Thirteen (13) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to 1st year Osteopathic Medicine students who meet all eligibility requirements.

<u>ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA</u>: To be considered for the Clark County Medical Society Scholarship, you must <u>also</u> meet the following criteria:

- Be a 1st year admitted student in the Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine program;
- Be in good academic standing 2.0 cumulative GPA at TUN; and
- Attended a Clark County high school, college, or university (attach documentation).

ESSAY: Please attach a written essay of between 300-500 words about how living in Clark County has impacted your decision to become a doctor. Include in your essay how your studies at Touro University have or will prepare you for caring for your future patients.

<u>Clark County Medical Society Alliance Scholarship:</u>

\$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to Osteopathic Medicine students who meet all eligibility requirements.

ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: To be considered for the Clark County Medical Society Alliance Scholarship, you must <u>also</u> meet the following criteria:

- Be an admitted student in the Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine program;
- Be in good academic standing with a 3.5 cumulative GPA at TUN; and
- Attended a Clark County high school (attach documentation).

ESSAY: Please attach a written essay of between 300-500 words describing what it means to you to be a TUN Osteopathic Medicine student. Include in your essay how being a TUN Osteopathic Medical student is preparing you to assist with meeting the health needs of Clark County, Nevada.

Comprehensive Cancer Centers of Nevada Scholarship:

Two (2) \$2,000 Osteopathic Medicine scholarships and one (1) \$1,000 Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) scholarship will be awarded to students.

<u>ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA</u>: To be considered for the Comprehensive Cancer Centers of Nevada Scholarship, you must <u>also</u> meet the following criteria:

• Osteopathic Medicine Applicants

- Nevada Residents will be given preference (attach documentation); and
- Must demonstrate an expressed interest in pursuing a medical career in the field of Oncology.
- Master of Science in Nursing Applicants
 - Nevada residents will be given preference (attach documentation)

ESSAY: Please attach a written essay of between 300-500 words describing what it means to you to be a TUN Osteopathic Medicine or TUN Master of Science in Nursing student. Include in your essay how being a TUN student has impacted you and/or others. Osteopathic Medicine students should include what drives you to pursue a career in the field of Oncology.

Christy and Alan Molasky Scholarship:

Up to two (2) \$2,500 scholarships will be awarded to qualified military veterans.

<u>ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA</u>: To be considered for the Christy and Alan Molasky Scholarship, you must <u>also</u> meet the following criteria:

• Must be a military veteran who has been honorably discharged from military service, please attach copy of your DD-214.

ESSAY: Please attach a written essay of between 300-500 words describing what it means to you to be a TUN student and how your military experience prepared you to be a TUN student. Include in your essay how being a TUN student is preparing you to assist with meeting the health/educational needs within your respective program of study.

Time Travelers Foundation Scholarship:

One (1) \$1,000 will be awarded.

<u>ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA</u>: To be considered for the Time Travelers Foundation Scholarship, you must <u>also</u> meet the following criteria:

- Be in good academic standing at TUN; and
- Must have a documented epilepsy or seizure disorder (attach documentation).

ESSAY: Please attach a written essay of between 500 - 1200 words about how your experience with seizures has impacted your life values and career goals. Include in your essay how your studies at Touro University have or will prepare you for your future career.

Master's in Camp Administration and Leadership Scholarship:

Multiple awards will be made to Master's in Camp Administration and Leadership students.

<u>ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA</u>: To be considered for Master's in Camp Administration and Leadership Scholarship, you must <u>also</u> meet the following criteria:

• Be an admitted student in the Master's in Camp Administration and Leadership program

ESSAY: Please attach a written essay of between 300-500 words about your camp leadership experience, service to the community, and how you would advance the betterment of the community through this academic program. Please include information about your personal background, community service, extracurricular activities, and any other information you think would be relevant to this scholarship application.
